♥ Church (Passion Christian Assembly/ PCA Church)



When I became a Christian, the Lord clearly spoke to me that I will be a pastor and a fisher of men for God's Kingdom. This seemed like a nightmare to me, having grown from one of the smallest families in a very rural village in Uganda. Over time, God has worked incredibly, slowly by slowly, in and through my life to reach out to thousands of people in Uganda. Yet each

time, God proved to be more than just my creator and Savior. He's also my sustainer, counselor, comforter, teacher, strength, protector, guide and provider of Jesus' ministry in Uganda through Care Medical Centre.

Thanks to everyone who gave sacrificially towards the construction of God's house. I have great news! The bricks we made locally incredibly reduced the costs of construction. The worship place is almost done, though we still need more materials to finish construction and to pay for labor. Your faithful giving has surely helped us to build His house. This structure has not only provided a place for worship, but it has also physically beautified our community. Thank you so much for your labor in The Lord. I assure you it isn't in vain. May God abundantly bless you.

We cannot wait for the birthdate of our church, and everyone is passionately preparing for the big day. Everybody is eager—choirs are practicing, preachers are sharpening their voices, and the African dancers are ready to perform. We thank God for the privilege to serve Him and the people in Uganda.



♥ Care Medical Centre



At Care Medical Centre we continue to be the leading health service provider in our community. This month God provided through friends from the U.S., and we had the opportunity to deliver free medical care to over 200 patients. We were able to distribute free antibiotics, anti-malarial drugs, and de-worming medicines. In the past three months, we have been able to share the Gospel and treat another 200 patients with various conditions such as malaria, pneumonia, burns, typhoid, worms, infestations and malnourishment. We are proud to be the only Christian, pediatric, and referral clinic in our community.

♥ Mercy Ministry and Home Cells



These initiatives have helped us strengthen our ministry as seen by numerous people joining our Saturday fellowship and souls turning to Christ. This gives us an opportunity to go deeper and form personal relationships with these people, disciple them, mentor them, teach them the Bible, and serve with them. It also allows us to meet people’s physical needs. In the past three months we have been able to provide food, shelter, and clothes to thirteen families by God’s grace, and we testify that all of these families have given their lives to Christ. Additionally, this month, with the help of one U.S. team we supplied 300 dresses and trousers to vulnerable children in our community.

These two arms, mercy ministry and home cells, have helped us to build a bridge between the ministry and the community. Many people have eventually opened their hearts to salvation and are yearning more to know the Bible. During our home visits, we have seen many families strengthened, husbands loving and providing for their families, and people surrendering their lives to Christ. Because of these two ministries and God's provision, no maternal abuse has been exhibited in these thirteen families for the last three months.

♥ Success Story - Kilabo Miracle, 6 months old



God's love is unconditional and everlasting. Miracle's mother had HIV/AIDS and developed postpartum illnesses and died after three days of giving birth to Miracle. This opened doors for suffering, and Miracle was left with no shelter, breast milk, security, or a future. She was abandoned and rejected, but God had a plan for her life. He allowed her to meet us, and our hearts connected with her and her story. Despite her being small for her age and size, severely dehydrated, and suffering from diarrhea and vomiting, we welcomed Miracle with open arms into our family and provided her with love and care. One week later, she was admitted into the hospital for severe malnutrition and very severe pneumonia, today Miracle is a living testimony. She is six months old and living happily, HIV negative, and has hope for her future like any other child. Miracle is a "miracle."

Miracle's story is your story. We were once abandoned, lonely, and neglected, but God loved us unconditionally and adopted us into his Kingdom. He has a plan and purpose for every one of us irrespective of race, color, tribe, region, religion, and sex.

♥ Sponsorship Program



In Uganda, 80% of the children are unable to attend school due to a number of reasons. In light of this, our ministry is appreciative to God for this sponsorship program. Currently, we have 200 children under this program, and 115 are receiving financial sponsorship to attend school, have meals and a pair of shoes. This program has helped us build a new godly generation as children attend Christian schools where they teach them the Bible. These children are able to attain knowledge to read and write reducing the illiteracy and ignorance rates in Uganda, and school dropouts and early young mothers and marriages have declined as

well. Most of these children are growing up to be responsible citizens and potential fathers and mothers to care for their families for tomorrow. The majority of these children in our sponsorship program are orphans, abandoned, or affected by the impact of HIV/AIDS and poverty.
